Mohpa is a city with a municipal council in Nagpur district in the Indian state of Maharashtra. Although physically located within Kalmeshwar taluka, it is not subject to taluka governance.. Mohpa is located on a tributary of the Chandrabhaga River. [2] It is 13 kilometres (8 mi) north-west of Kalmeshwar and 34 kilometres (21 mi) north-west of Nagpur. It has an average elevation of 351 metres (1151 feet). As of 2001 India census, Mohpa is a Municipal Council city in district of Nagpur, Maharashtra. The Mohpa city is divided into 17 wards for which elections are held every 5 years. The Mohpa Municipal Council has population of 6,987 of which 3,520 are males while 3,467 are females as per report released by Census India 2011. Population of Children with age of 0-6 is 615 which is 8.80 % of total population of Mohpa (M CI). In Mohpa Municipal Council, Female Sex Ratio is of 985 against state average of 929. Moreover Child Sex Ratio in Mohpa is around 922 compared to Maharashtra state average of 894. Literacy rate of Mohpa city is 88.28 % higher than state average of 82.34 %. In Mohpa, Male literacy is around 93.78 % while female literacy rate is 82.72 %. Mohpa Municipal Council has total administration over 1,637 houses to which it supplies basic amenities like water and sewerage. It is also authorize to build roads within Municipal Council limits and impose taxes on properties coming under its jurisdiction... Mohpa had an average literacy rate of 74%, higher than the national average of 59.5%: male literacy was 81%, and female literacy was 66%. In Mohpa, 11% of the population was under 6 years of age Distance from College: 36 KM and 370 Meters


